ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Students who have passed 10+2 examination or any other equivalent examination from any recognized University.
- Students seeking admission in Honours Course should secure 45% total aggregate in 10+2 level or 45% in the concerned subject.
- Students who have completed Diploma/Certificate course after passing class 10 with minimum duration of two or more years from a recognised University/Board, UGC and AICTE are eligible to seek admission to First Semester
- Students may shift from Science or Commerce stream to Arts, provided he/she has secured 45% of marks in aggregate in 10+2 level.
- Science and Commerce students securing 45% marks in English in their 10+2 level examination shall also be eligible to take admission in English Honours.

AMBIENCE AT SALESIAN COLLEGE OF HIGHER EDUCATION

LIBRARY

ATTENDANCE

The college demands 80% attendance in each subject per academic session. 5% relaxation in case of sickness and casual leave may be allowed. Students having less than required percentage of attendance will be barred from the Selection/University examinations.

- Students must wear proper uniform and identity card, whenever they come to the College.
- Assembly is compulsory; motivational talks and information is passed on during this time.
