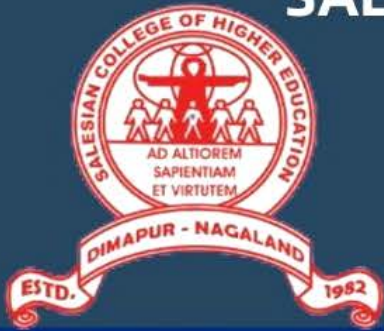

ELIGIBILITY

Students who have passed 10+2 examination or any other equivalent examination from any recognized University/ Board shall be eligible to seek admission to the first semester of the FYUGP.

- Students seeking admission in Honours Course must secure 45% total aggregate in 10+2 level or 45% in the concerned subject.
- Students who have completed Diploma/Certificate course after passing class 10 with minimum duration of two or more years from recognized University/Board, UGC and AICTE are eligible to seek admission to First Semester.
- Students may shift from Science stream to Commerce, Arts, and Commerce to Arts provided he / she secured 45% of marks in aggregate in 10+2 level.
- Science and Commerce students securing 45% marks in English in their 10+2 level examination shall also be eligible to take admission to English Honours.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

A SIMPLE SIX – STEPS ADMISSION PROCESS

- For admission application form log on to Website [www: https://schedimapur.edu.in](https://schedimapur.edu.in) fill the form and pay Rs. 300/- to the office.
- Submit the filled-in application form along with the required documents.
- Take spot admission if you have 45% and above
- Pay the college fees and obtain the college ID Card.
- Place an order for your College Uniform.
- Attend the orientation programme on the 1st & 2nd July 2024

- NBSE Registration Card in original and one self-attested photocopy (for students from NBSE)
- Migration Certificate in Original for applicants coming from outside Nagaland Board.

- One self-attested photocopy of HSSLC & HSLC Examination Admit Cards.
- One self-attested photocopy of Birth Certificate
- One self-attested photocopy of Schedule Tribe/ Community Certificate

SCHE ATMOSPHERE

Salesian College of Higher Education is a shrine of learning and everyone is expected to create a favourable atmosphere for it. SCHE Campus is an eco-friendly campus with beautiful plantations which is conducive for learning. It has wellfurnished class rooms, with audio-visual facilities. The college has a football ground, two volley ball courts and a basketball court. It has also a well-furnished auditorium which serves as multi-purpose hall.

LIBRARY

The college is well equipped with a library having nearly 60 thousand books. It is a reference cum lending library. It remains open for consultation/ reference and lending from 9 am to 3 pm. The Library uses eBLIS – a software for Library Management. eBlis is a user friendly solution designed to take care of all the administrative and management functions of a Library. The College is also an active member of the National Digital Library (NDL) Club and N-LIST (National Library and Information Service programme of UGC- INFLIBNET since 2023. It provides access to eBooks, eJournals and eResources. The library also has a documentation section where Newspapers, Magazines, Journals etc. are bound and preserved for further reference and consultation. The students are also provided with internet facility for e-learning activities.

STUDENT EXTENSION PROGRAMME

NSS, Red Ribbon, Bosco Club, Literary Club, Eco-Club, NCC, Yuva Tourism Club and Media Club. Seminars, Panel Discussions and Special Courses are part of the educational programme of the college. Students can opt for special courses on Educational Psychology and Ethics.

DRESS CODE

Uniform of the college is cream colour shirt, black formal trousers and black shoes. College 'T' Shirt with Logo imprinted, black trousers and black sandals on Wednesdays and Saturdays. The students who attend class without proper uniform will be fined. In winter students are to wear black coat or blazer.

APPEARANCE

- Bleaching and colouring of hair is strictly prohibited for both boys and girls.
- Inappropriate short hair is strictly prohibited for girls
- Shaved haircut, bald cut (brush-cut over the ears) bald head/cut and growing long hair are strictly prohibited for boys.
- Spiked hair and fancy hair styles of any kind are strictly prohibited.
- No students shall keep his/ her hair in any manner which can make the hair look unusual or over stylish than the normal student look.
- Tattoos of all kinds are strictly NOT allowed.

FOR FEMALE STUDENTS



- Hair must be neat and clean.
- Shoulder length hair or longer than shoulder length should be tied up.
- Only one ear-stud per ear is allowed and the ear studs for Both ears must be of the same design.
- Ear-studs must be of a simple design and not fanciful.
- Dangling earrings are NOT allowed.

SALESIAN COLLEGE STUDENTS/BOSCONIANS

- Bosconians must wear proper uniform and identity card, whenever they come to the college. Daily attendance at the start of the college for a short prayer session is mandatory.
- The students are expected to be in the college campus during the entire period of the college hours.
- Possession and use of addictive substances like tobacco, supari, pan etc., are completely forbidden in the college campus.
- Students must be present on the re-opening day after every vacation and on the last day before every vacation, major or minor; those who fail to do so shall pay fine.
- Minimum class/ subject attendance required to be eligible to sit for the examination of the college/ university is 80% Punctuality is to be observed by all at the college campus.
- Usage of mobile phone is prohibited in the college building campus.
