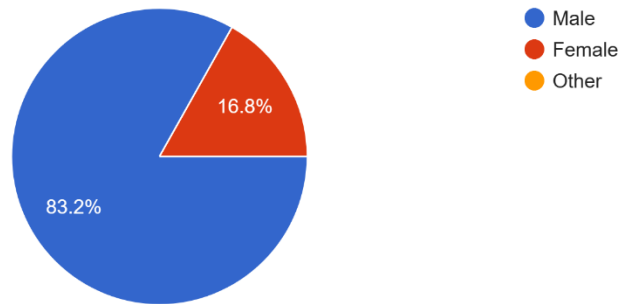
Feedback by Alumni: 2022

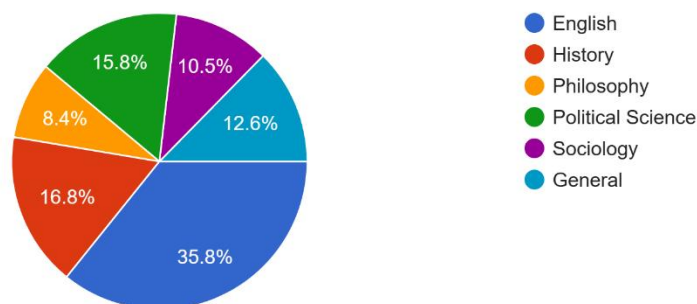

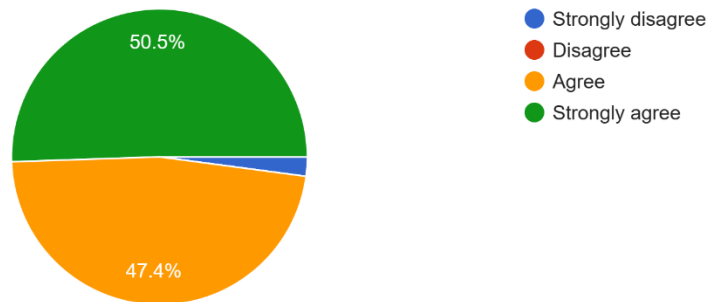

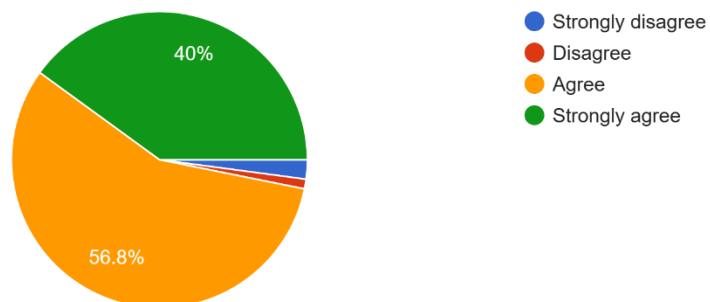

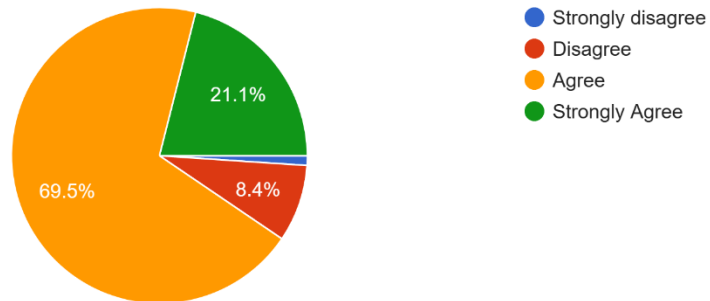

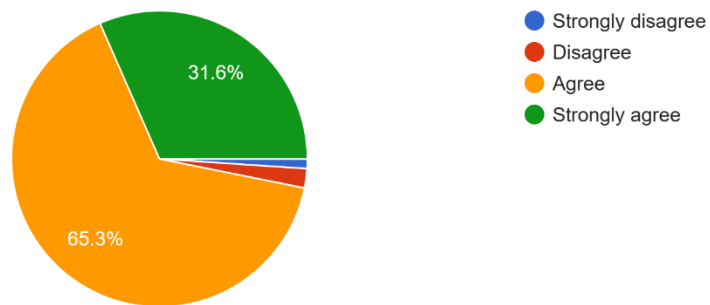

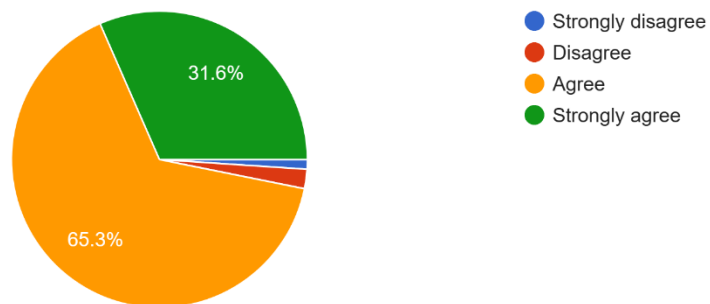

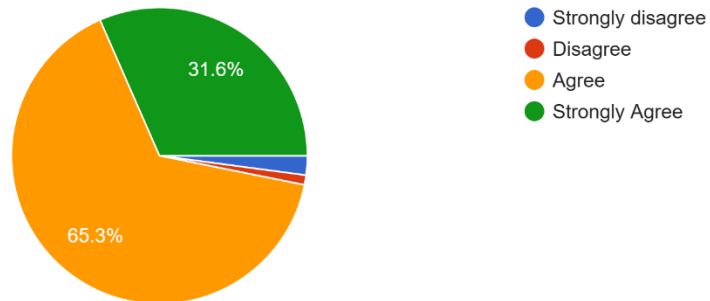

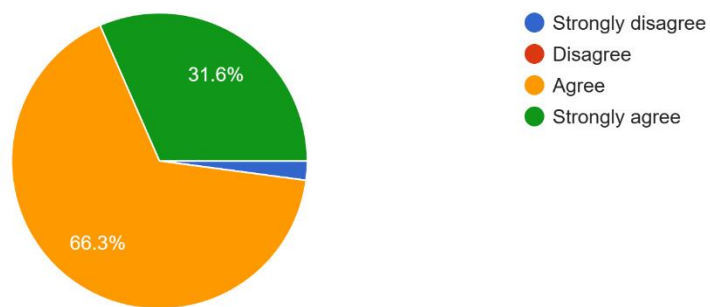

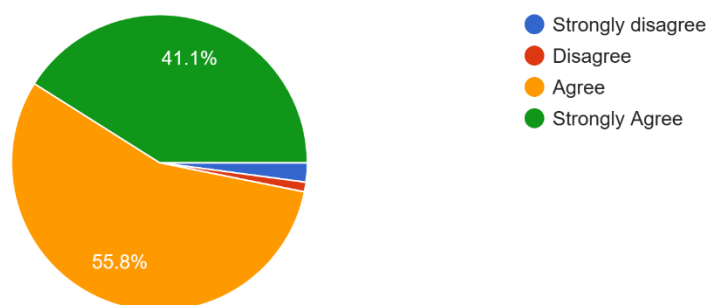

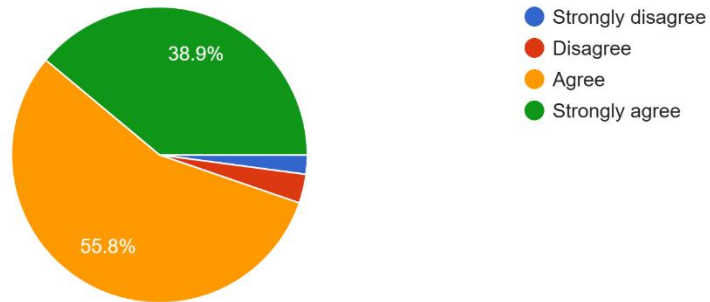

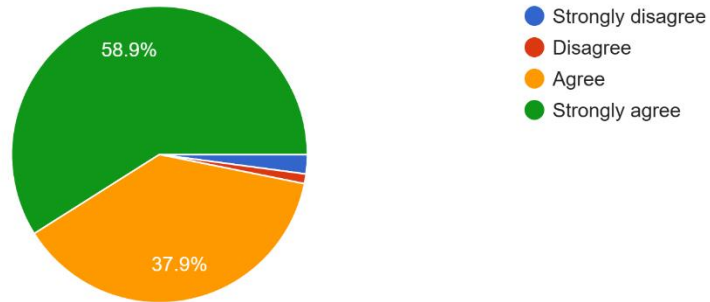

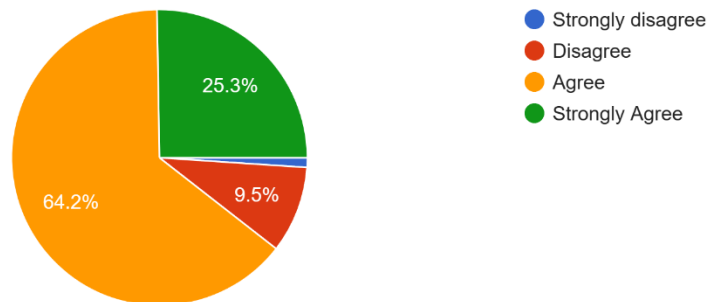

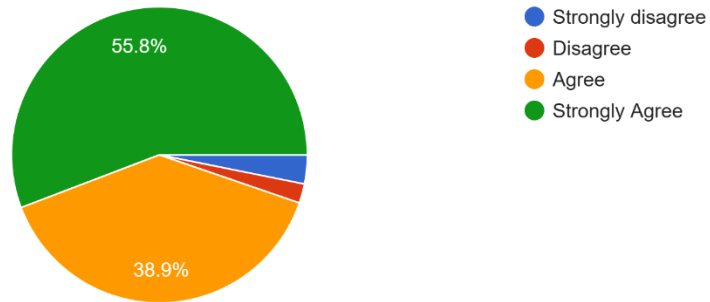

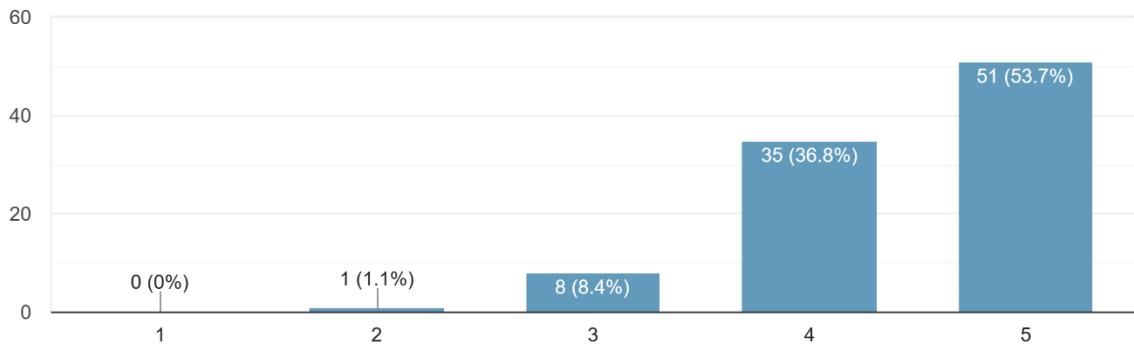

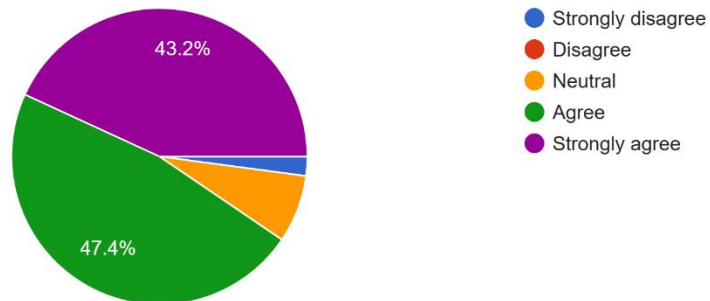

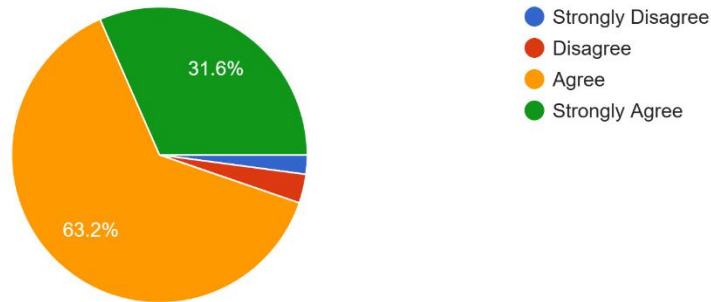

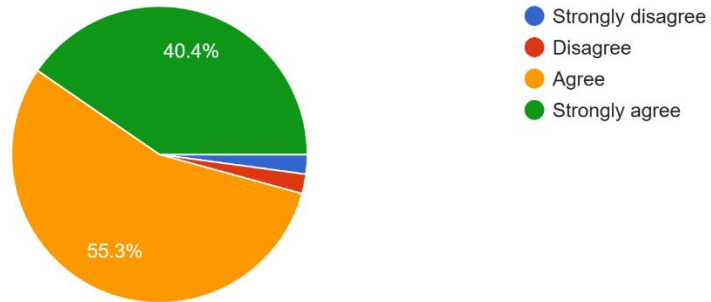

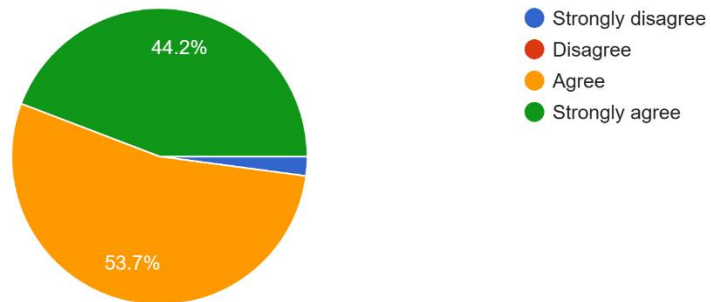
