

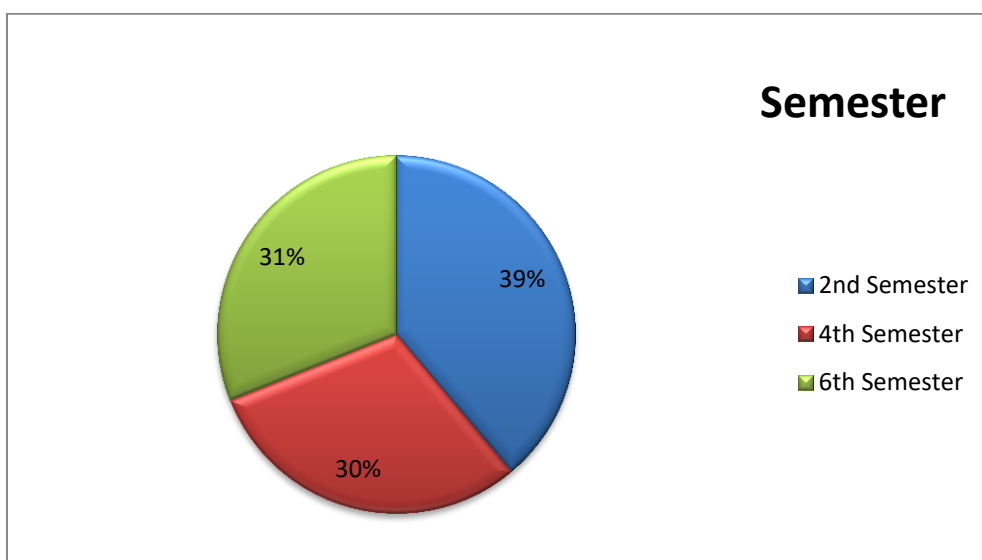
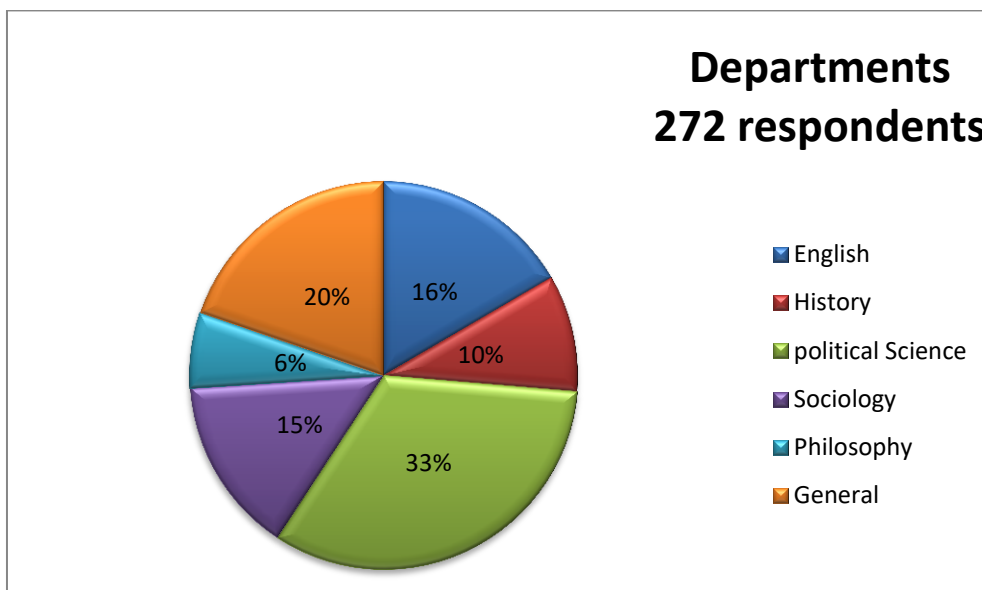

EVALUATION OF THE FEED BACK ON THE INSTITUTION BY STUDENTS

ACADEMIC YEAR 2021 - 2022

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell initiated a feedback from students on academic performance and ambience of the academic session 2021-2022 which were collected manually. A total of 38 questions were directed to 272 students representing all six departments of the college.

The department and semester wise distributions of responses are given below in the following two charts:



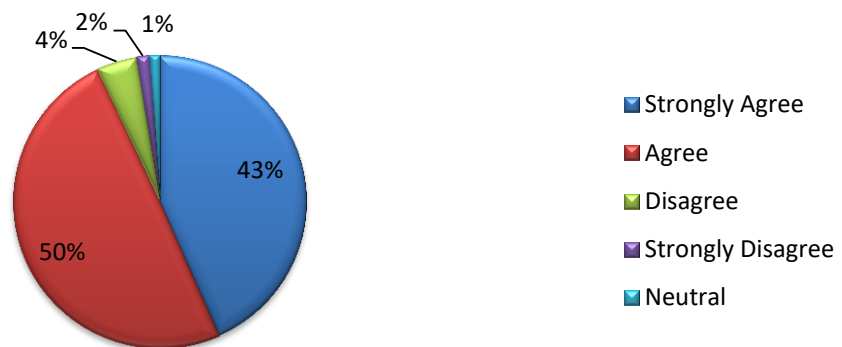
INFRASTRUCTURE

1. Classrooms are in order and well maintained : Responses :272



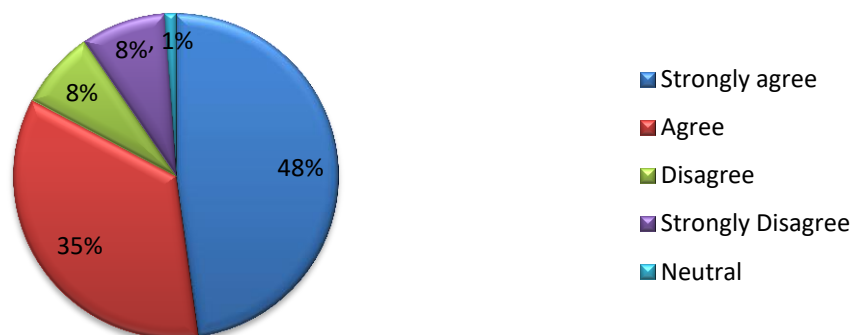
Students in general are satisfied with the cleanliness and management of the classrooms. Out of 272 responses 90% responses were affirmative and only 10% were negative.

2. Clean drinking water is available in the campus (Responses : 272)



It is noted from the analysis that students are provided with clean drinking water as 93% students feel that clean water is available in the campus for drinking

3. The lavatories and clean and well maintained (Responses : 272)



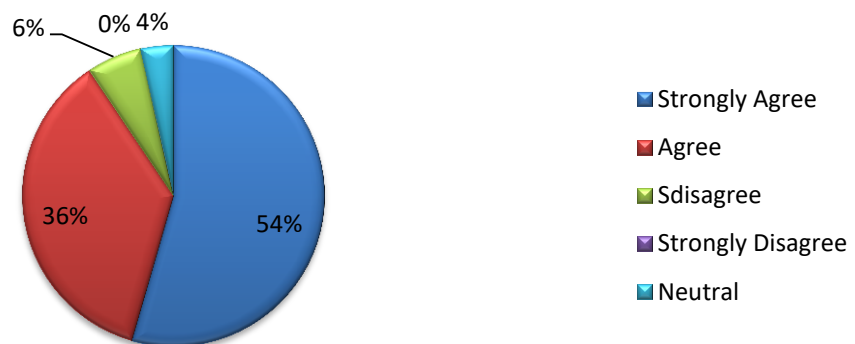
The analysis on the feedback of the students reveals that 83% affirm that the lavatories are clean and they are maintained well while 17% differed in their opinion

4. College provides adequate hostel facilities (Responses : 272)



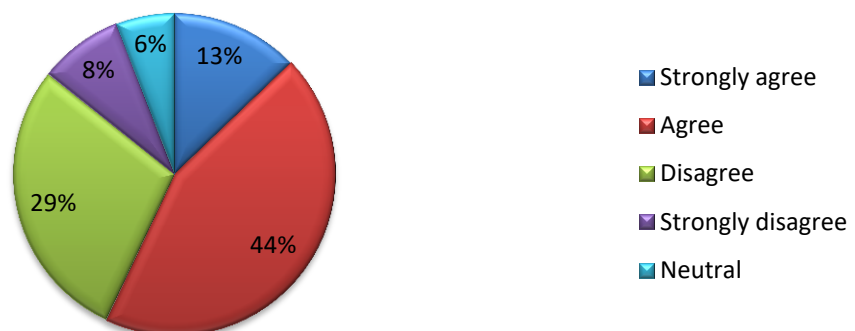
The analysis reveals that the college needs to provide more hostel facilities for the students as 55% students disagreed to the statement that college provides adequate hostel facilities and 10% felt the college provides enough hostel facilities and 10% remained neutral to the statement.

5. There are adequate number of dustbins in the classrooms and college campus (Responses : 272)



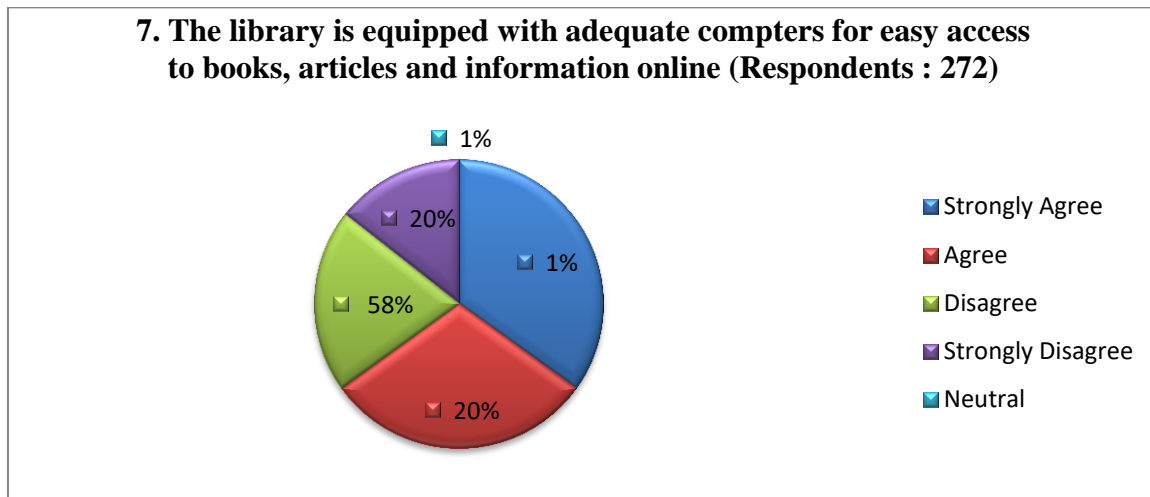
91 % of the responses show that the college has adequate dustbins in and around the college while 6% disagreed and another 4% remained neutral

6. Adequate measures are taken in terms of installation of CCTV, fencing and walling of campus: (Responses 272)

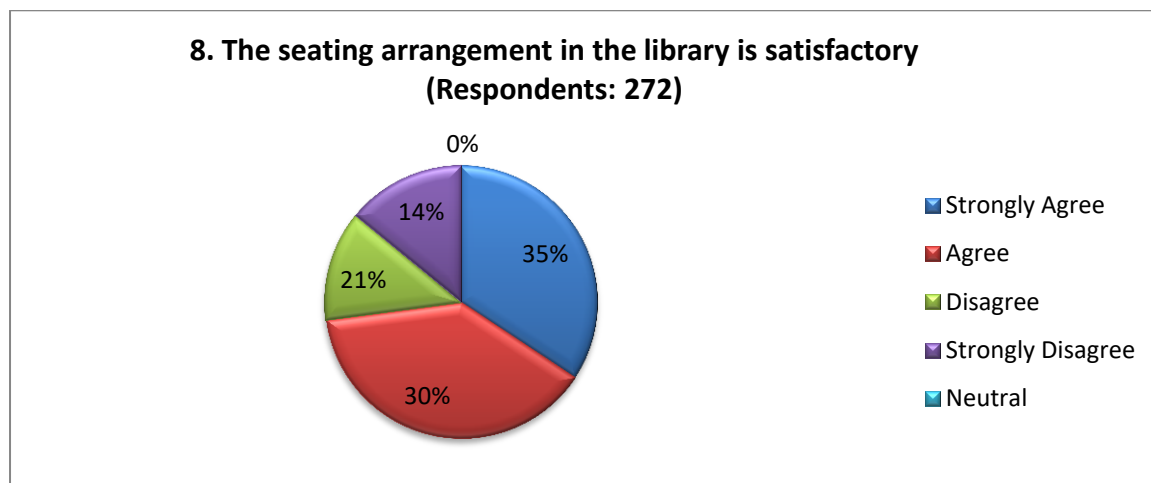


57% of the respondents affirmed that adequate installation of CCTV is done and fencing and walling of the campus is done and maintained, 43 % respondents disagreed to it.

LIBRARY



The analysis explains that out of 272 responses 78% felt that the library is not well equipped with computers for easy access to books articles and information online while 20% felt that the library is well equipped with computers and another 1% remained neutral to the question



Students spend quality time in the library for reading, preparing notes and assignments, preparing for seminar and the like. The findings on the seat arrangements in the library indicate that the library has good seating arrangements and capacity to include many students at a time. 65% responses affirmed that the seating arrangement in the library is satisfactory while 35% negated it.

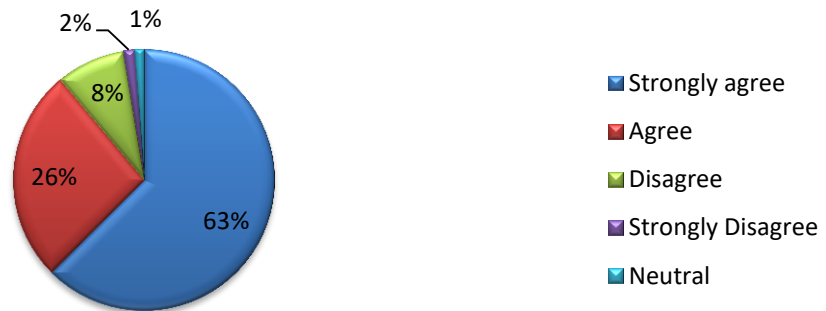
9. The books recommended by the teachers are available in the library. (Respondents : 272)



The library has a good collection of books. Every department has adequate books in the library. The Chief librarian and the assistant librarians update and maintain the library. 77% of the respondents were of the opinion that the library has adequate books while 23 percentage felt that it needs improvement

10. The staff in the department are approachable (Respondents: 272)

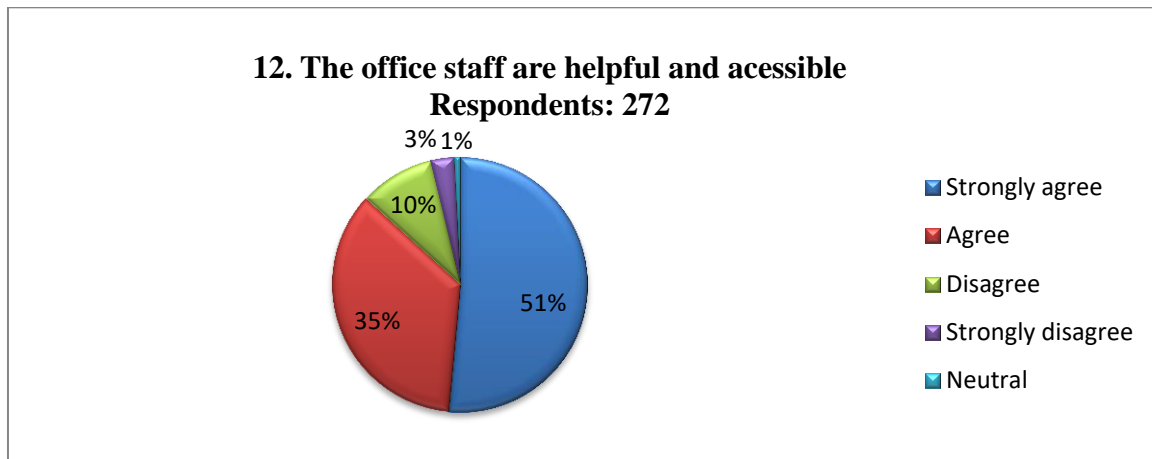

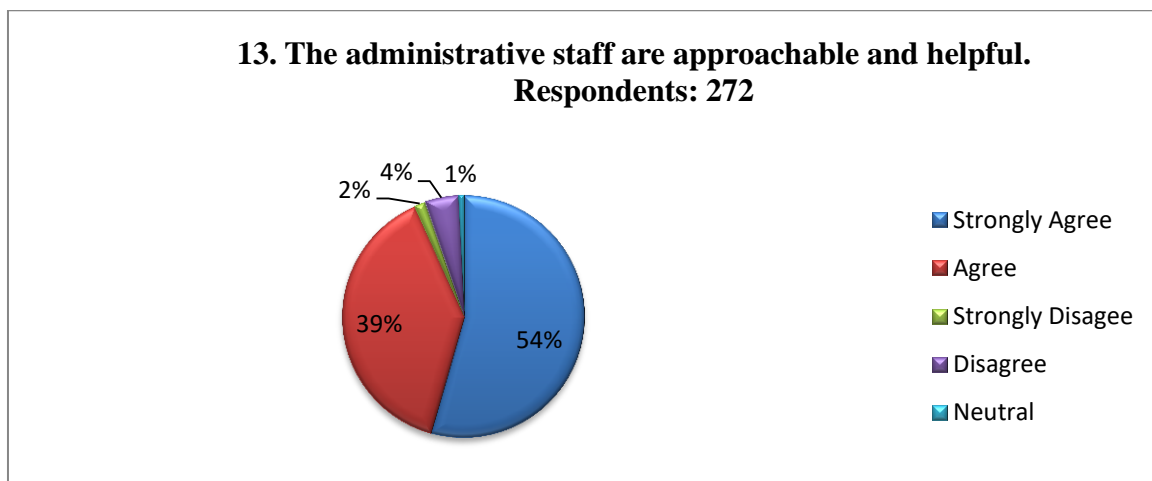
11. The library staff is friendly and readily available for assistance (Respondents 272)



The dealing of the library staff with the students is satisfactory. They are readily available to help out the students and are gentle in their dealings with other. There is a good rapport between the library staff and the students. The feedback from the students affirms that the staff is readily available for any assistance as 90% respondents confirms it while only 10% of respondents have negative response.

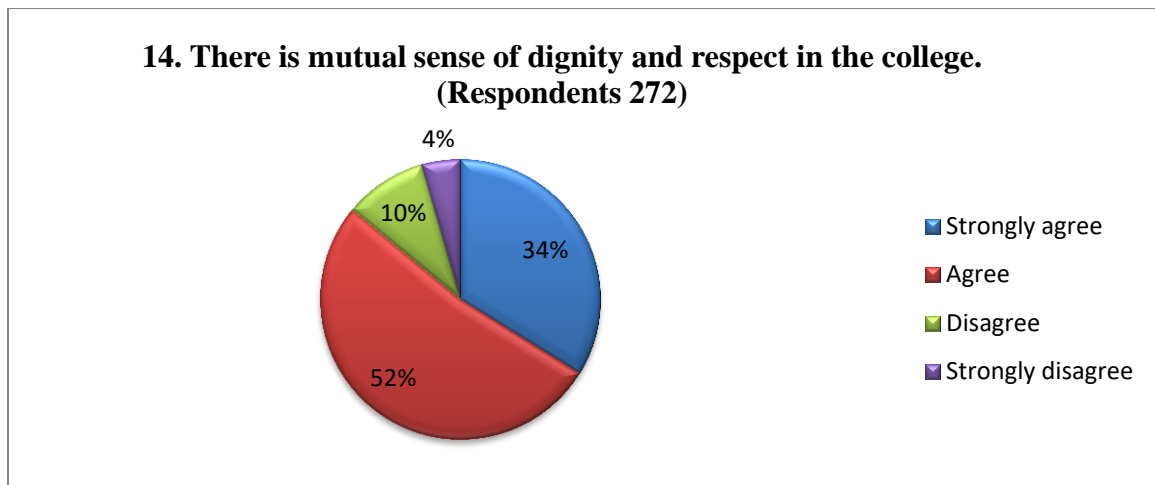

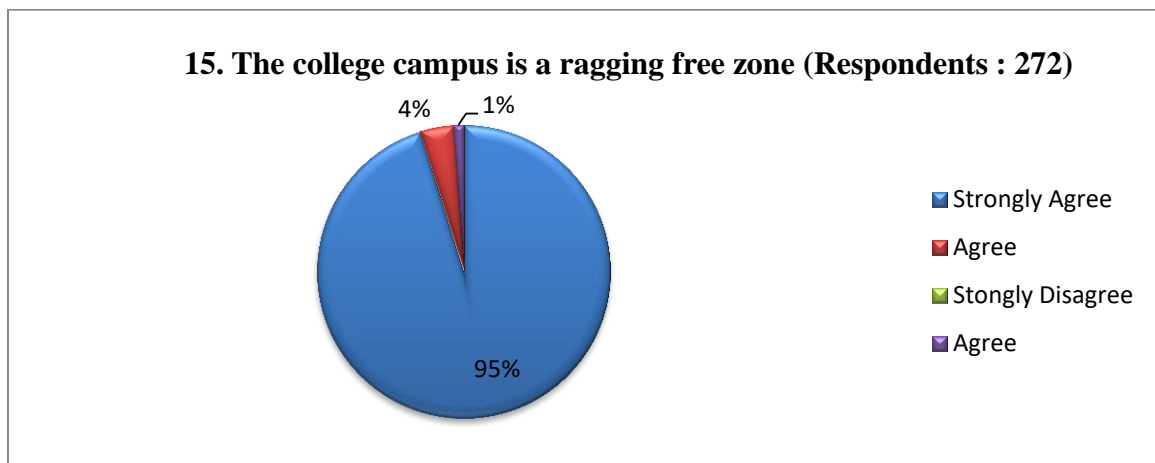

CAMPUS CULTURE



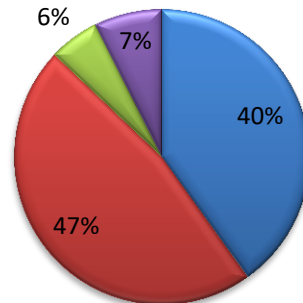

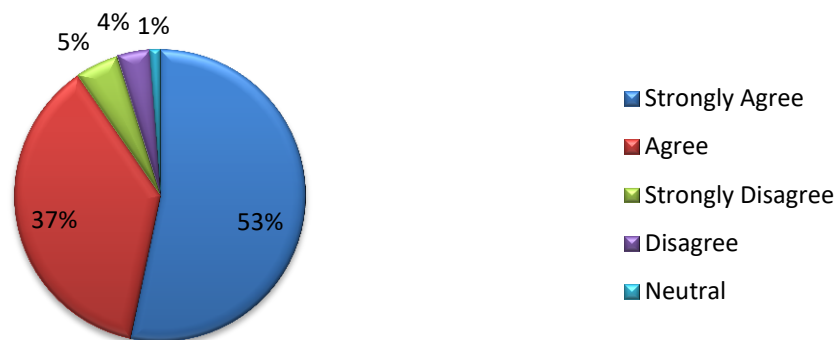
TEACHING METHODOLOGY

16. The teachers are able to stimulate the mind of the students into critical thinking (Responses : 272)



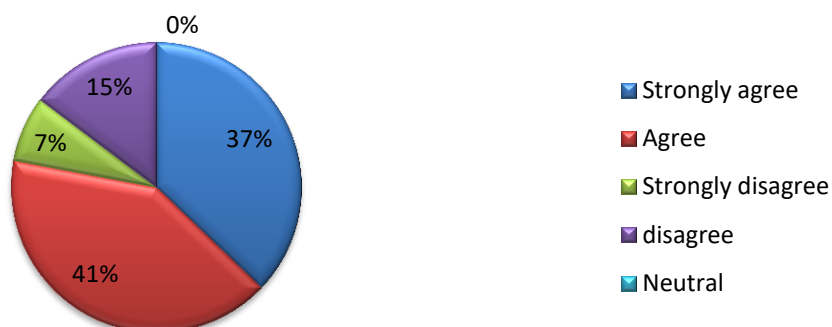
Teachers provide ambience for the students to develop their ability for critical thinking through various activities and teaching methods, seminars, symposium and other activities involved in teaching and learning. A total of 87 % respondents affirmed that the teachers are able to stimulate the mind of the students into thinking critically while other 13% disapproved it.

19. Teachers prepares their lessons well (Respondents: 172)



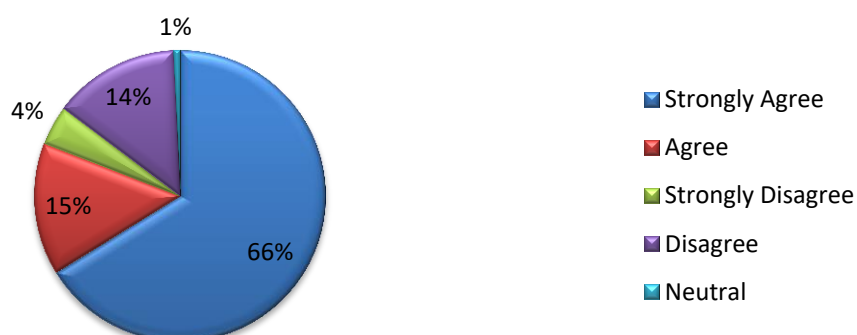
Teachers do prepare for classes well and regular to the class. They use various methods in teaching which will help the students to get involved in thinking and to keep their mind focused. 90 % of the respondents affirms that their teachers prepares well for classes while 10% were not satisfied with the preparedness of the teachers for the classes

**20. The teachers focus on student centric learning

Teachers do take initiatives to make the teaching student centric and outcome based. 78% of the respondents affirmed that the teachers focus on student centric learning while 22 % negated the statement

**21. Teachers use ICT /Modern Technology in teaching learning
process (Respondents 272)**



Classrooms are provided with Projectors and also sound system so as to enable their teaching more student centric and outcome based. 81% of respondents agree that the teachers use modern technology in their teaching while 19% disagreed.
