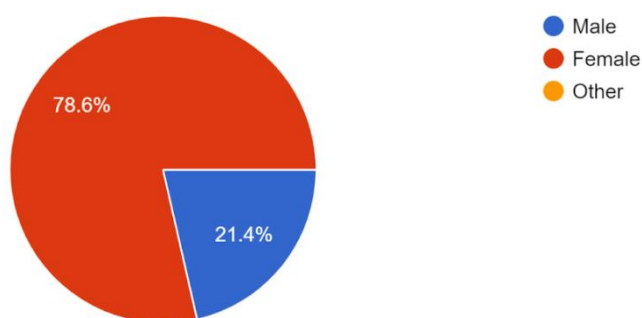

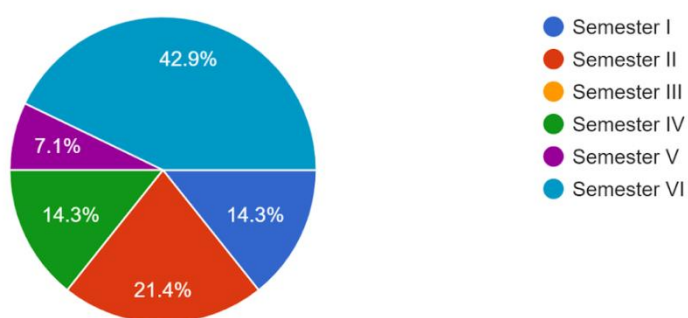

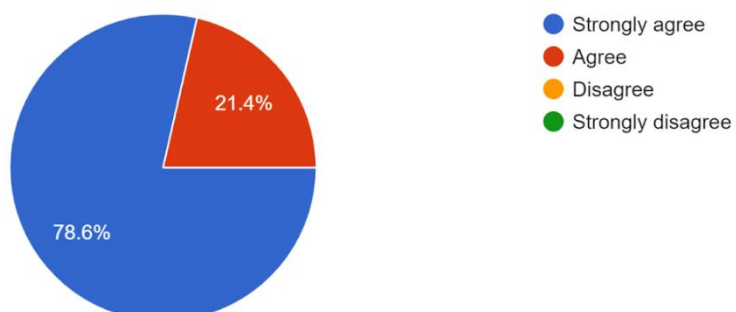
Semester which you are teaching

1. Students are informed of the course outcome of each course

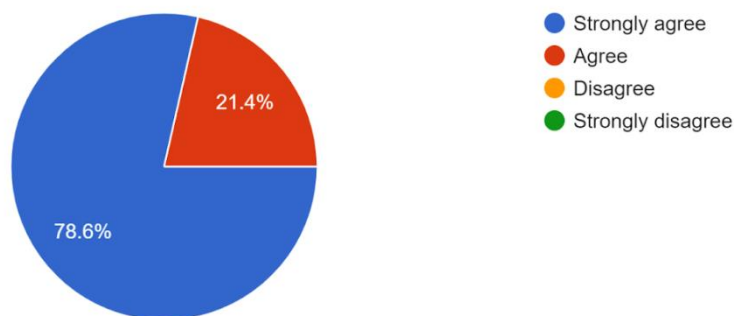

2. Innovative methods of teaching and continuous evaluation are used by the teachers

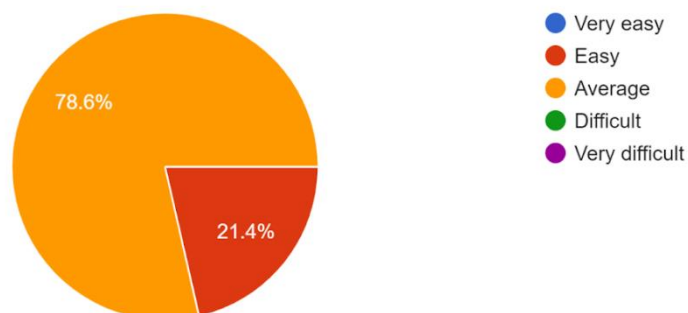

3. My rating on the difficulty level of the syllabus

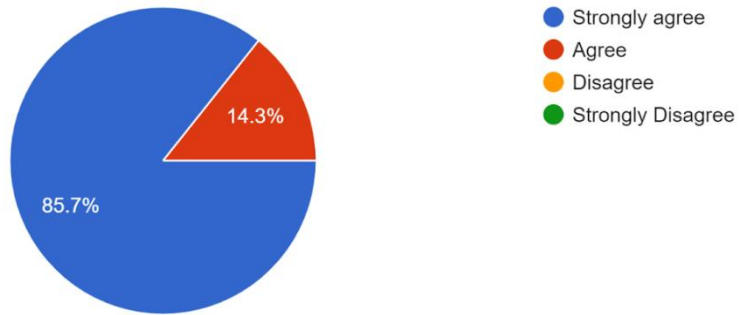

4. Plan of study/activity is given to the students well in advance by teachers

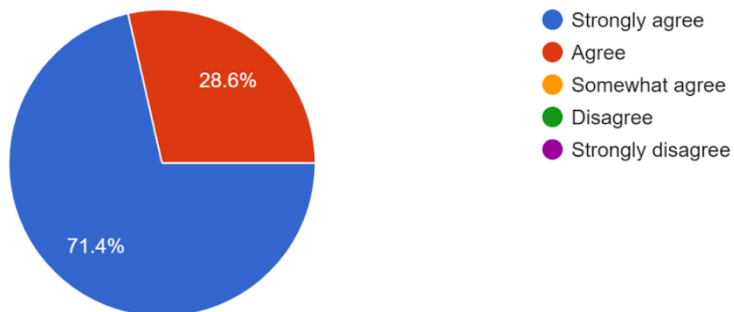

5. Seminars and assignments are designed in such a way as to help the students to grow on their own

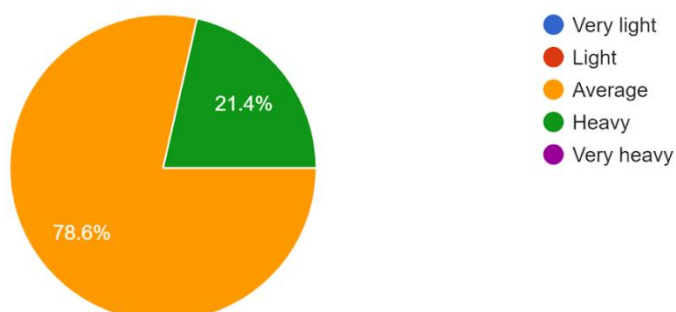

6. The workload of the syllabus I am teaching this semester is

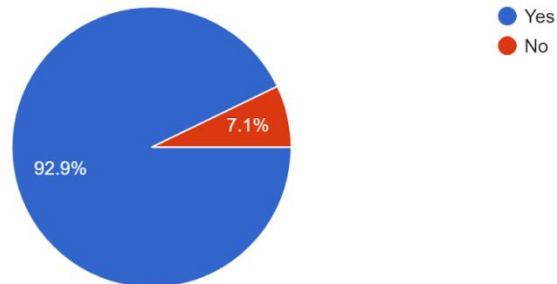

7. Are you satisfied with the update of the curriculum?

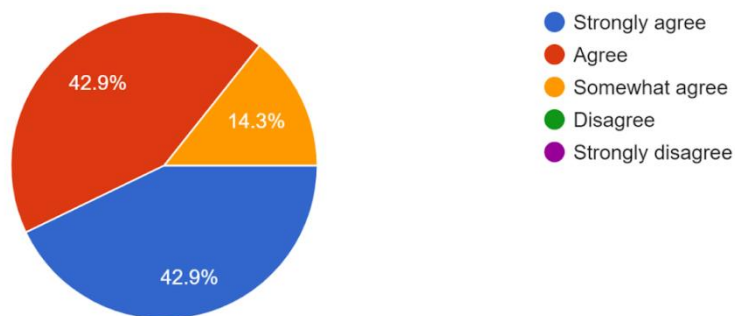

8. I am able to complete the course on time.

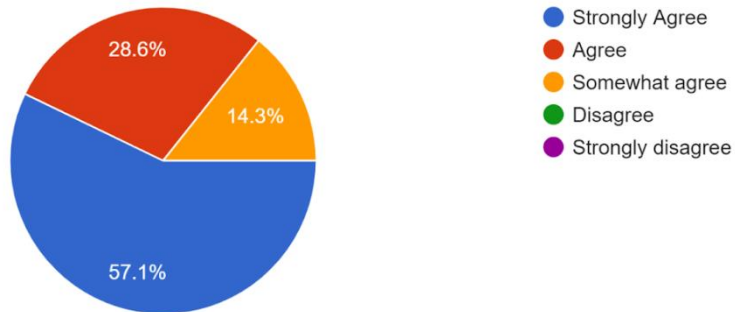

9. Is the curriculum in time with technological changes.

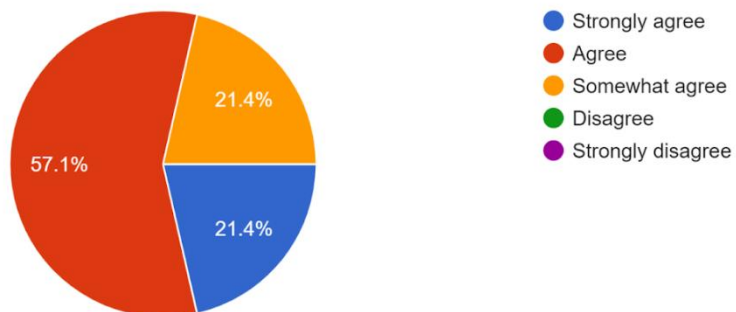

10. The topic in the syllabus is intellectually challenging and stimulating.

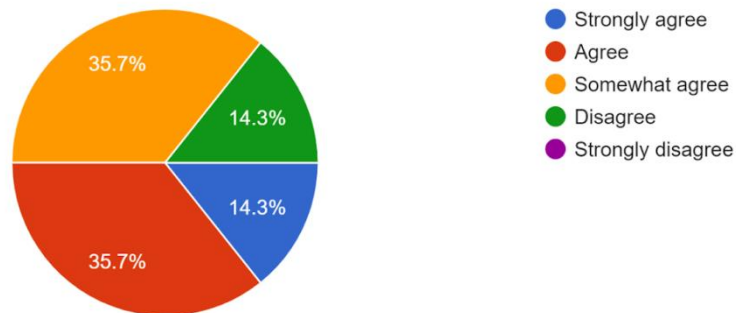

11. Reference material and books are easily available for the topics mentioned in the syllabus.

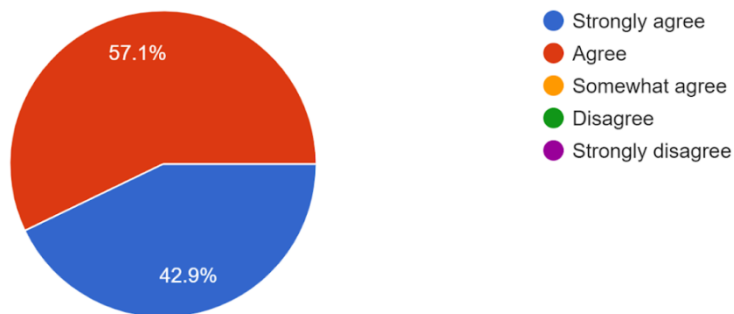

13. The curriculum and syllabus are designed to give necessary subject knowledge and skills for students to enroll for a higher education in the subject inside/outside Nagaland.

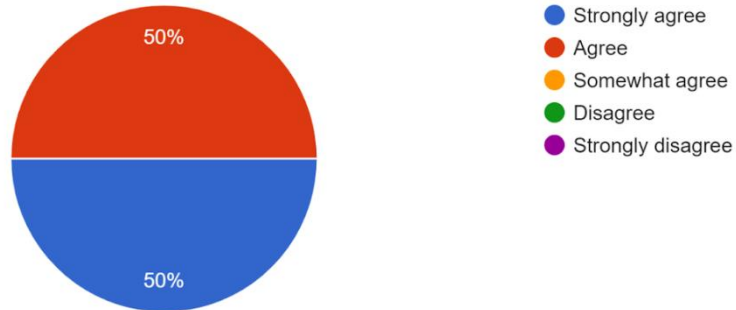

14. The college gives adequate career/higher education orientation to students

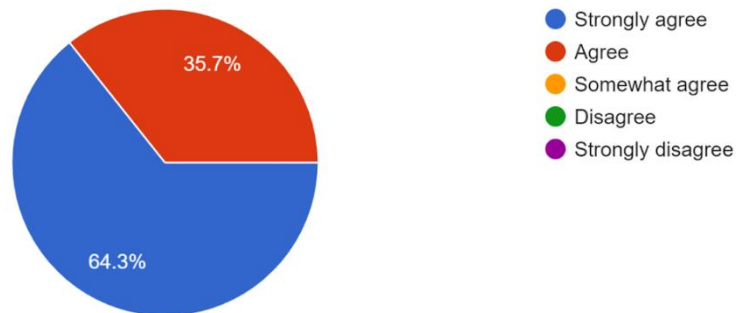

15. The college has a well-functioning mentor system

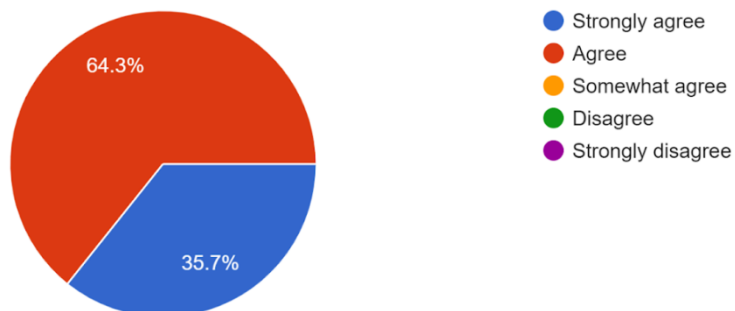

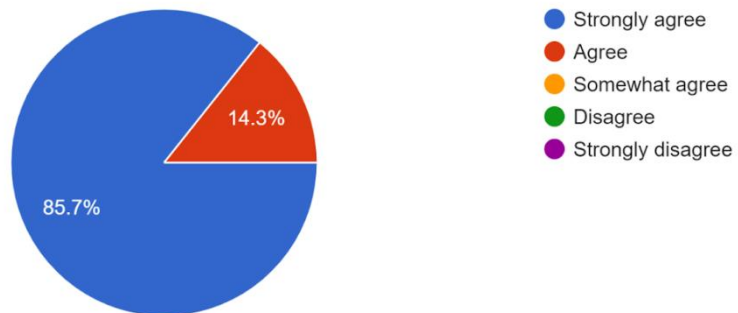


The respondents are confident that the college is committed to making the students

17. The college has a peaceful environment

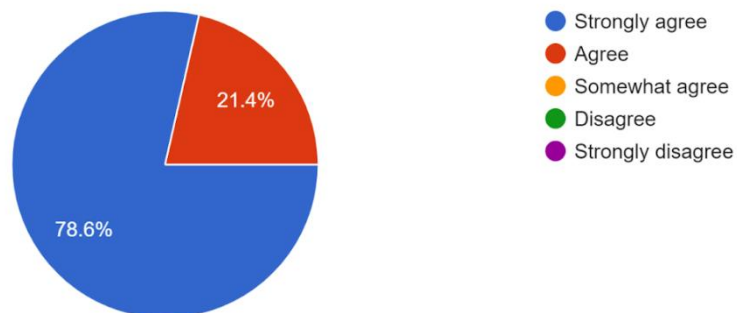

18. The college provides basic amenities. (drinking water, toilet, sanitary pads, first aid etc.)

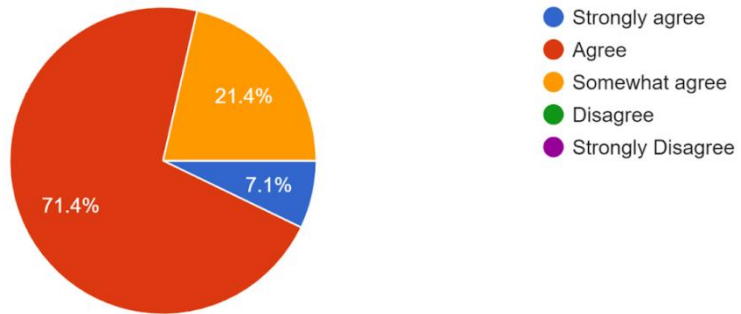
