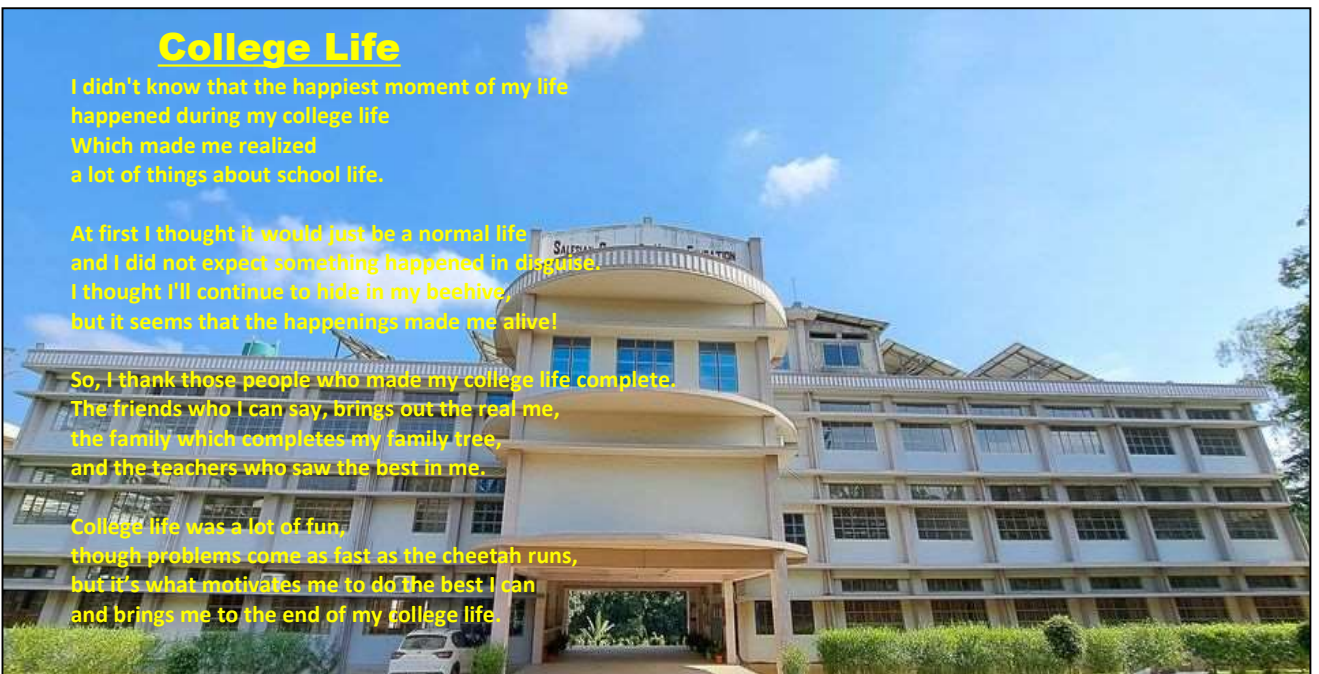
**College Life**
