



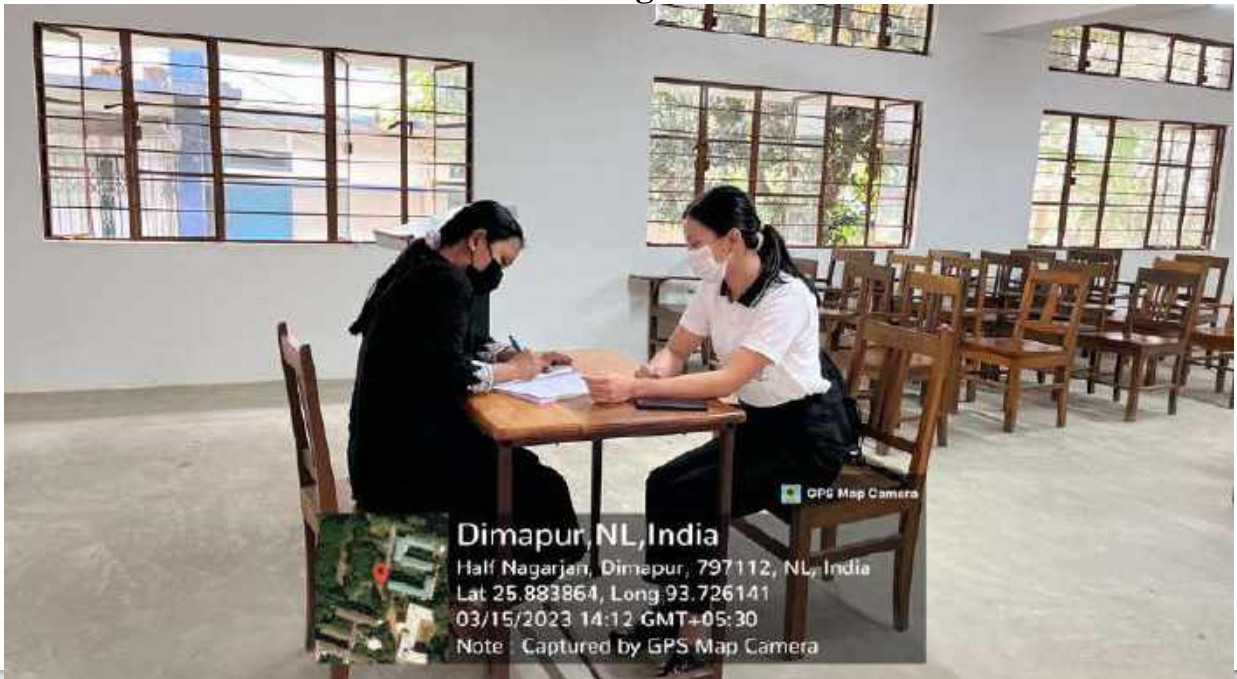

- A mentor may share with a mentee information about his or her own career path, as well as provide guidance, motivation, emotional support, and role modeling. A mentor may help with exploring careers, setting goals, developing contacts, and identifying resources.
- Good mentors are enthusiastic people, enjoying the role they play in helping others achieve their goals. ... While considering a mentor, look for someone who is enthusiastic, respectful of others and a respected expert in their field.

2. Put the responsibility in the mentee's hands...
3. Be willing to offer constructive criticism. Offering constructive criticism is essential to helping your mentee progress toward their goals. ...

4. Most Important Tool

Active listening. Active listening is one of the most important Tools used in the mentoring process.

4. Focus of mentoring

Mentoring is a learning relationship, generally focused on long term career development. The primary purpose is to drive personal growth; building skills, knowledge and understanding.

5. Objectives:

1. The last Friday of the every month is mentor's day.
2. The mentor meets the mentees in common to motivate, guide and to follow the mentee.
3. Choose a topic for an each mentor's day share your experience from your life and ask them to share their life experience.
4. Personal mentoring is important for the student. It should be done in the college campus.
5. A mentee can fix an appointment for personal chat on college working days.
6. The appointment can be fixed in person with mentor, if mentor is busy mentee can leave a sheet or their mentor book with vice principal or IQAC to get their appointment fixed.
7. It is the duty of the mentor to inform the management in writing, for any kind of serious issues connected to the mentee.
8. The overall formation of the mentee is important in this process of mentoring. The mentee should be well balanced physically, mentally, emotionally, intellectually and socially.
9. It is very important to know the background of the mentee, family situation and circumstance of his/ her brought up before starting your comments, advice and mentoring.
10. Do not give immediate solutions. Listen to their problems and give them positive outlook.

Step 2 - Listening actively and asking questions.

Step 3 - Facing them or turning toward them during the session to show your engagement.
