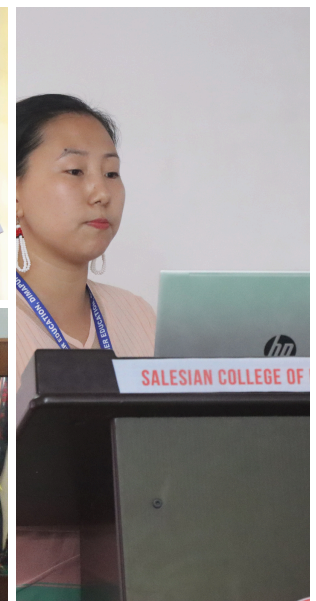
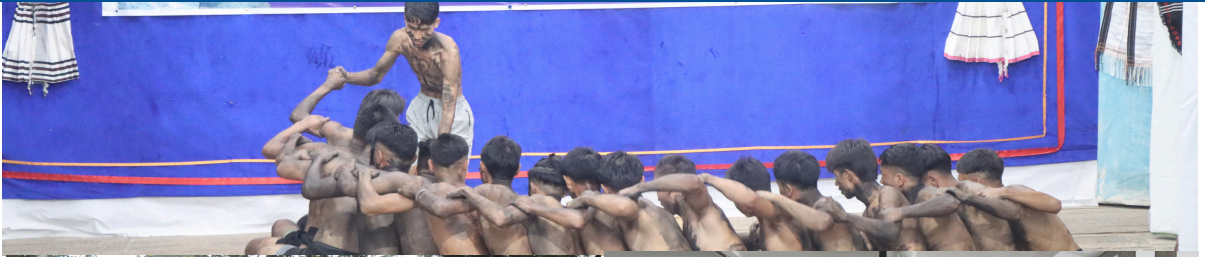
The NAAC peer team visited the college to assess the quality of the educational institution's academic, administrative and infrastructural standards. The evaluation was to ensure that the college meets the standards for the accreditation and continuous improvement.

The team evaluated the curricular aspects and interacted with the head of departments, visited academic departments, assessed the institution's infrastructure and conducted onsite review of the facilities to verify their adequacy for supporting the academic environment.

The second day the team examined the safety and security measures including counselling services. The institution's environmental sustainability efforts were also looked into. The visit concluded with a formal exit meeting in which the final report was handed to the principal.

The week long journey allowed different colleges of northeast to gather and experience the breathtaking scenery, rich culture and share God experience.

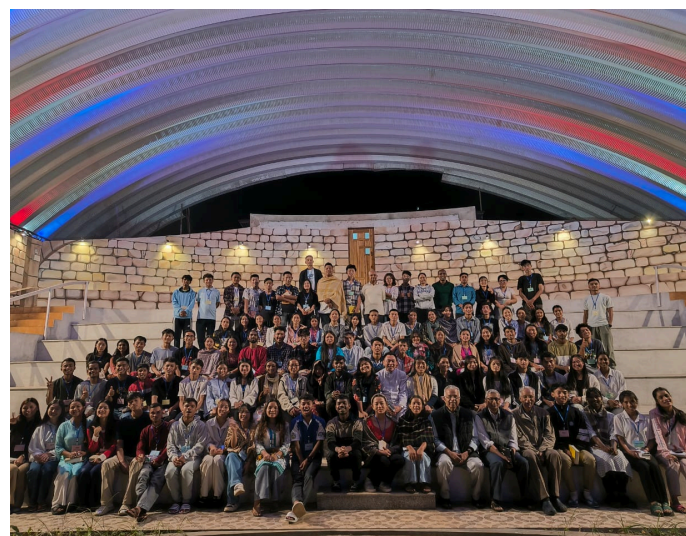


Siloam, Umiam Lake
